There is no application fee, and admitted students are automatically considered for merit scholarships (of up to \$21,000 per year) - there is no additional

application required. With proper documentation, students will also be considered for financialneed-based aid (approximately \$5,000 per year). The total cost to the student next year (including room, board, travel, books, and health insurance) will be approximately \$13,000 per semester. We require TOEFL or IELTS; SAT scores may be substituted for the language proficiency scores, but we do not require SAT scores.
