NORTH CENTRAL COLLEGE (IL) INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

North Central is a nationally-recognized liberal arts university near Chicago, Illinois that was founded in 1861. North Central's International Scholarship is an academic scholarship for undergraduate students that is offered to qualified students at the time of admission. The award ranges up to \$20,000 per year (up to \$80,000 over four years) and is renewable if the student remains in good academic standing. Grades, test scores, essay and teacher recommendations are considered in the award review.

NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY (KY) INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AWARDS

Northern Kentucky University is a growing metropolitan university of nearly 16,000 students served by more than 2,000 faculty and staff on a thriving suburban campus near Cincinnati. Every semester the Office of International Student and Scholars award approximately ten scholarships to new students.

This award is called the International Student Award and is in the amount of \$1,000/ semester. All new international students are automatically eligible for this scholarship when they apply to the university. It is not necessary to fill out a separate application for the International Student Award. Recipients of the International Student Award will be chosen based on test scores and grades.
