The TOEFL iBT Preparation Course is available for \$150. Students will be responsible for purchasing the Official Guide to the TOEFL Test, Fourth Edition textbook for \$21.95. Students may purchase and download the eBook or order the paperback textbook through the official ETS website.

The TOEFL iBT Preparation Course is designed for students who have an intermediate to advanced knowledge and understanding of the English language before beginning the course.

The deadline to apply for the TOEFL iBT Preparation Course is Friday, February 21st, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. (MST).
