UNIVERSITY OF OREGON OFFERS WIDE VARIETY OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Oregon provides various scholarships for its international student population. For example, the International Cultural Services Program (ICSP) consists of 30-40 renewable scholarships that apply to tuition only and range from \$6,000 to \$20,000 per year.

The ICSP scholarship has a cultural service component that requires students to give presentations about their home country to children, community organizations, and faculty, staff, and fellow students at the University of Oregon. These scholarships are based on financial need, academic merit, and the ability to make presentations to diverse groups of people. ISIP is open to both undergraduate and graduate students.

Additional scholarships and fellowships for international students who demonstrate financial need and academic merit include the International Dean's Excellence Award (IDEA) for New International Students, the Pressman Family Scholarship, and the Jim and Jean Tattersall International Student Scholarship.
