The University has reset its cost structure for full-time undergraduate tuition and financial aid resulting in a cost cut of more than \$10,000 for the 2014-15 academic year.

The tuition reset, which will apply to all full-time undergraduate students enrolled in 2014-15, represents a 37 percent decrease from the projected 2014-15 tuition of \$30,064, bringing it to \$18,908.
