	Source Network Administration Using Solaris OS Description: This course will prepare students for the Sun Certified Network Administrator (SCNA) Exam. This course also provides hands-on experience with topics such as Internet Protocol (IP) routing, Domain Name System (DNS), Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP), IP version 6 (IPv6), and the Solaris IP Filter firewall.
