Activities:

- Visit Companies
- Visit Universities

Expense Covered:

- Air ticket (Return)
- Accommodation (Separate accommodation for male and female)
- Local Transport (as per program schedule)
- Food Ingredients (Students must cook their own meal. Basic cooking utensils and condiments will be provided)
- Any other expense not mentioned above, must be borne by the students, i.e. Visa Fees, etc.

Application Requirements:

- Must be a registered AIUB Student (Undergraduate only)
- Minimum Credits completed: 60 Credits
- Minimum CGPA Requirement: 3.25
- Must have passport with minimum 6 months' validity at the time of travel
- Knows how to swim (Preferred; but not mandatory)
- Knows how to ride bicycle (Preferred; but not mandatory)
- Students from any discipline may apply

Screening and Grooming Process:

- Short listed candidates will be required to write an essay (topic will be given to short listed candidates only)
- Short listed candidates will participate a mandatory 2-day workshop
- A review will be done after the completion of the workshop
- Based on the workshop review result, candidates will be called for a final interview
- Candidates will be selected based on the result of the final interview

- Date of the workshop: Thursday, May 31 and Saturday, June 2, 2018
- Review of the workshop: Monday, June 4, 2018
- Final Interview: Thursday, June 7, 2018
- Final selection of candidates: Monday, June 11, 2018
- Apply for Japanese Visa: Sunday, June 24, 2018
