 - A total GPA of 5.50 with a minimum GPA of 2.75.
 - Total of 1200 marks (SSC and HSC exam) with 45% in English in H.S.C. level
 - Minimum GPA 2.5 (in both O and A Levels separately) with no grade lower 'D' among best 5 subjects in O' level and best 2 subjects in A' level. (Scale: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 & E=I)
 - High School Diploma/International Baccalaureate with minimum grade C.
 - **For H.S.C. Appeared Candidates, required S.S.C. CGPA is 3.00

International Students

- Possess valid Passport & Visa
