Commendation at CAA Awards 2024 for Architecture Student

The Department of Architecture at AIUB proudly announces that Shahira Sarwat, an Architecture student, has received Commendation at the Commonwealth Association of Architects (CAA) Awards 2024 under the "CAA Presidents' Awards" category. Shahira's thesis project, titled "Heritage Sanctuary for Geology," was completed during the Fall 2023-2024 semester under the guidance of studio teachers Ashik Vaskor Mannan and Irfat Alam, with Arefeen Ibrahim serving as the project supervisor. The project focuses on the preservation of the unique geological features of Jaflong, Sylhet, a region known for its ancient limestone formations, Kopili Shale layers, and boulder beds dating back to the Eocene epoch. Additionally, Shahira's project has been shortlisted for the final round of judging for the ARCASIA Thesis of the Year Award 2024, where it was selected as one of the three projects from the national level.

WePOWER launched its Bangladesh National Chapter (BNC) on June 10, 2024, where AIUB was an honored invitee. AIUB also established a 10-member gender committee and, with WePOWER, hosted a seminar on "Female Students' Career-Building Opportunities in the Power Sector" on September 23, 2024.

AIUB Makes its Mark in Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2025


October 17, 2024, Thursday

3rd International Conference on Computing Advancements (ICCA) held at AIUB

October 20, 2024, Sunday

The 3rd International Conference on Computing Advancements (ICCA), themed "Age of Computing and Augmented Life," was held at AIUB on October 17-18, 2024, organized by the Department of Computer Science in cooperation with ACM SIGAPP. ICCA 2024 received over 400 submissions, with 145 papers accepted in fields like Intelligent Systems, Machine Vision, Cryptography, and Human-Computer Interaction, to be published in the ACM Digital Library.

The two-day conference began on October 17, 2024, at the AIUB Auditorium, with addresses from Dr. Carmen Z Lamagna (Chief Patron, ICCA 2024; Member, Board of Trustees), Prof. Dr. Khandaker Tabin Hasan (Conference Chair; Head, Graduate Program, Computer Science), Prof. Dr. Md. Abdur Rahman (Special Guest; Pro-Vice Chancellor), and Prof. Dr. Saiful Islam (Chief Guest;

Vice Chancellor). The event included eight keynote speeches from leading figures in computing.

At the ICCA 2024 closing ceremony on October 18, Mrs. Nadia Anwar, Founder Member and Chairman of the Board of Trustees at AIUB, expressed her appreciation to the participants, volunteers, and organizers for their contributions.
