November 2, 2024

On November 2, 2024, AIUB hosted the "Cisco IoT Hackathon 2024," featuring 125 programming teams from educational institutions across the country. In the final competition, 20 teams presented their projects to a distinguished panel of judges.

The first prize of 50,000 BDT was awarded to Team Underrated for their project, "Smart Farm Management System Using IoT for Enhanced Agricultural Productivity and Disaster Mitigation." The second prize of 30,000 BDT went to Team Sohayok for their project, "A Cost-Efficient Device for Individuals with Cerebral Palsy Utilizing IoT." The third prize of 20,000 BDT was awarded to Team Artificial Intelligence Bangladesh for their

project, "Interactive Educational Bot for Children using IoT." Mrs. Nadia Anwar, Chairperson of the AIUB Board of Trustees, and Prof. Dr. Saiful Islam, Vice Chancellor of AIUB, presented the prizes to the winning teams. A Webinar on “Project Planning and Proposal Writing”

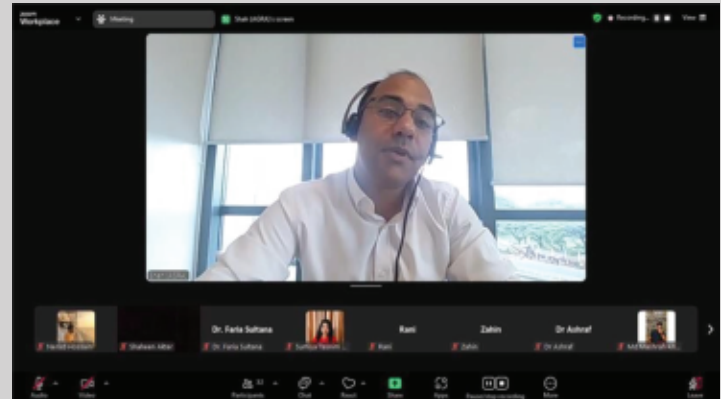
November 28, 2024
